

- Camp Guidelines -

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian and Child:

Please go over the below camp guidelines with your child/children before the date of their adventure. We have a desire for every person at our camps to enjoy themselves and to be safe. However, it is also important to remember to respect others and their property. We want to leave our camps in a condition that is better than when we arrived.

First and foremost:

ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOL, DRUGS, OR WEAPONS OF ANY TYPE ARE TO BE BROUGHT TO CAMP

CANOPY AREA:

- 1. No child is permitted to be in the area of the lighter fluid or in the cooking area (canopy area) where there are propane tanks, stoves, matches, etc.
- 2. If for some reason a child does need to retrieve an item from the canopy area, it is necessary to obtain permission from a adult.
- 3. No child is permitted within 10 feet of any grill or coals outside the canopy area.
- 4. No child is permitted to go through the packing boxes. These boxes are for our cooks.
- 5. No child is permitted to utilize the ice chest without a camp authority.
- 6. There is a limit of two (2) sodas per day per child while at camp.

TENTS:

- 1. Zippers on our tents are fragile and may break, so please handle them with care. If a zipper becomes stuck, please ask an adult for assistance.
- 2. Do not use sticks to bang on tents to scare other adults or children inside the tents. This may result in a hole in the tent which would then need to be repaired.
- 3. Absolutely no food, candy, snacks, pop, or gum inside the tents. <u>If these items were to be inside the tent, animals may try to get inside to get them.</u> No food or drink other than bottled water inside the tents.
- 4. Tents are to be used only to sleep in, take a nap, or change clothes in they are not for playing inside.
- 5. No gas lanterns or heat sources are permitted inside the tent.

WEATHER:

1. In the event of wind, storms, or other weather that is deemed unsafe for both the children and the adults, camp will immediately be cancelled and the children will be sent home.
